Web-enabled controllers

The new iSeries devices connect directly to an Ethernet network with a standard RJ-45 connector. The devices, which send and receive data in standard TCP/IP packets, send e-mail to notify engineers of an alarm condition or update the status. The Ethernet and Web server capability is actually embedded in the device, which is assigned an IP address on the network and can also be assigned an easily remembered name, such as "Heater 1."
